This year was the 5th consecutive year that the RFHD programmes have been offered in South Africa, and in support of the **D9350 Steering Committee Chair, Bev Frieslich** and **rfha** **RFHA Advisor and RFHD Programme Director, Sue Paget** (who also lives in our Valley) it was decided that we should extend our sites into TWO areas not covered before, namely Red Hill informal settlement, near Simon's Town and the central area of Fish Hoek, in addition to the Ocean View and Masiphumelele sites that have been serviced in previous years.
