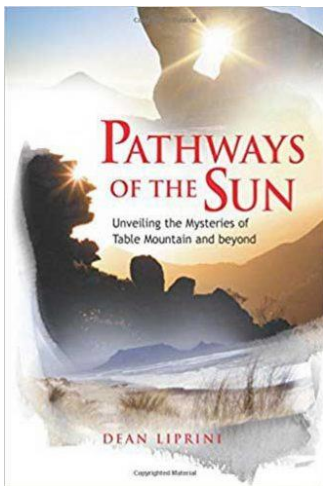

Our guest speaker, **Dean Liprini**, the author of "*Pathways of the Sun - unveiling the mysteries of Table Mountain & beyond*" gave a fascinating talk on his work as an Archeo Astronomer/Researcher of these Sunpath Sacred Sites or Earth Temples, & has also been instrumental in creating jobs in cultural tourism for the descendants of the Khoi San nation in Ocean View. In 2012 he founded and NPO - the "Sacred Site Foundation of Southern Africa" to create a greater awareness & help protect these and other Sacred Sites across Southern Africa. He has produced an independent thesis, exploring not only the various physical academic sciences, Archaeology, Astronomy, Geology, Geography and History, but also the Sacred Geometries, Spiritual and Metaphysical Healing aspects enshrined within these Sacred Sites.
