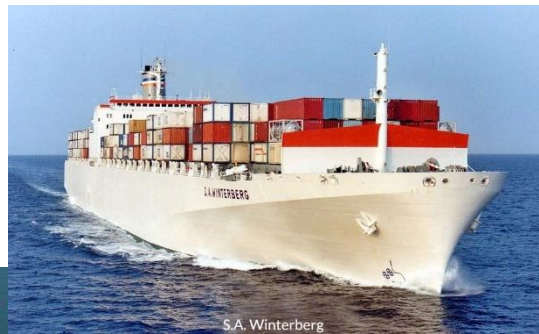
SERVE TO CHANGE LIVES
