Working together with the Rotary Club of Constantia

In recognition of Women's Day in August, the Rotary Club Cape of Good Hope in conjunction with the Rotary Club of Constantia and their Steenberg Rotaract Club, donated 28 "Comfort packs" to Captain Beziek from the South African Police's Muizenberg Unit, for abused children at the Family Violence Child Protection and Sexual Offences, based next to the SAPS offices in Fish Hoek.



The comfort packs were obtained from **Matla A Bana**, an organisation run by Monique Strydom, who is involved in the prevention of secondary abuse of children. Matla A Bana provides training for the SAPS, medical personnel, and educators in dealing with secondary child abuse in the recently renovated garage of the house in Fish Hoek, which provides a beautifully decorated child friendly interview room. Our Rotary Club together with Constantia RC and the Rotaract Clubs have been approached to help clear the garden of the cottage so that the children can play a safe environment.
