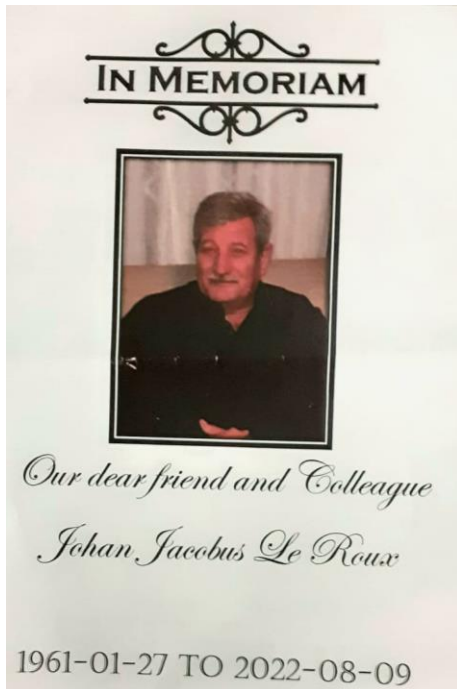


SUNDAY 4 SEPTEMBER.....is the
